JOHAN BACKTEMAN – TAKETOMIKAI MASTERCLASS 2025

On May 25, 2025 the <u>Taketomikai - Mendrisio Martial Arts club</u> will have a special guest, Johan Backetman (8. dan, Sweden) an expert in karate, goshindō, iaidō, kobudō. All are invited to take part in his multidisciplinary masterclass to be held at the <u>Canavée School</u> <u>Center Gymnasium in Mendrisio</u>.

JOHAN BACKTEMAN

Johan Backteman is 8. dan hanshi of karate of the Kunibaryū school, is also an expert martialist in the disciplines of Kunibaryū goshindō, iaidō, kobudō and is the president of <u>Chikubukai Europe</u>, an association that aims to disseminate the teachings of the Kunibaryū school, founded by master <u>Shōgō Kuniba</u>, 10. dan. Kunibaryū is descended from Motobuha Shitōryū, a style originating in <u>Okinawa</u> that developed in Japan in the mid-20th century. Motobuha Shitōryū was founded by master <u>Kosei Kukuba</u>, a student of the Okinawa king's grandson, <u>Chōki Motobu</u>, and later of <u>Kenwa Mabuni</u>. Adopted son and pupil of Kosei Kokuba, Shōgō Kuniba became head school (sōke) of the Motobuha Shitōryū and later developed his own system of karate, self-defense (goshindō), iaidō (Japanese sword drawing - katana), and kobudō (traditional Japanese weapons) that would take the name Kunibaryū.
